

Every Child Ready to Read Display Board-Wayne County Public Library, Wooster

The children's staff created an ECRR2 display board to feature the six skills and five practices plus give caregivers activity ideas to do in the library and at home. This display is used for programs like Come And Play and the ECRR2 workshops or special displays where ECRR2 can be promoted.

The display board consists of:

- Three panels with each representing one part of the ECRR program: five practices, six skills and activities.
- The five practices panel has a diamond shape for each practice and a highlighted practice sheet.
- The six skills panel has an oval shape for each skill and a highlighted skill sheet.
- The activities panel has a frame that holds a sheet of activities that caregivers can do in the library during the program.
 - Eventually, there will be a sheet that caregivers can take home with them to try other activities at home.
- There is a large Every Child Read to Read logo sign on the top of the display board.
